**Summary Narrative**

On December 9, 2022, at about 12:08 p.m., Idaho State Police (ISP) Detective (Det.) Hugh Powell and I, ISP Det. and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Task Force Officer (TFO) Gideon Roberts interviewed [REDACTED] regarding his interactions with Kaylee Goncalves. Goncalves had been a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] from January to March, 2022.

**Narrative**

1. On December 9, 2022, at about 12:08 p.m., ISP Det. Powell and I interviewed [REDACTED] regarding his interactions with Goncalves. Goncalves had been a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] from January to March, 2022. Det. Powell and I met with [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED], located at [REDACTED] Moscow, Idaho. What follows is a summary of the interview. For full details, refer to the audio recording. After advising [REDACTED] of the purpose of the interview and that the interview would be recorded, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

A. He first met Goncalves in January of 2022 when she was placed [REDACTED] by the University of Idaho (U of I) as a [REDACTED], which was part of the requirements of her [REDACTED] degree.

B. Goncalves was initially timid and struggled to connect with [REDACTED], which he attributed to complications of the COVID-19 lockdowns.

C. Goncalves did [REDACTED] titled, "Fun Festivals of Africa", during her time as a [REDACTED].

**Narrative**

D. The only time he had contact with Goncalves outside of their professional relationship was when he took his three daughters and wife to Goncalves' sorority house so his daughter could sell chocolate bars to the sorority as a fundraising event for an international trip.

E. The only communications he had with Goncalves was regarding her role as a [REDACTED] and was typically via text message.

F. He will periodically take [REDACTED] to get coffee after they successfully complete their [REDACTED], but he couldn't remember definitively if he had taken Goncalves to coffee during her time in [REDACTED]

G. He couldn't remember the exact dates but knew Goncalves was a [REDACTED] from January to March, 2022.

H. On the night of November 12, and into the early morning hours of November 13, 2022, he was at home with his family. He was with his three daughters at home while his wife, [REDACTED] was at a "Ladies Night" from about 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. He put his children to bed at about 9:00 p.m. and then he went to bed shortly after. When his wife arrived home around 10:00 p.m., he was already asleep in bed. [REDACTED] called his wife while we were speaking and placed it on speaker phone. She provided the same information as [REDACTED] previously provided.]

2. [REDACTED] was initially agreeable to providing a deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) exclusionary sample but was hesitant to allow his cellular telephone (cell phone) to be forensically extracted. [REDACTED] had to leave to [REDACTED] but agreed to provide the DNA sample later that evening, after discussing the matter of the cell phone extraction with his wife.

3. At about 5:00 p.m., [REDACTED] contacted me by phone and told me he intended to seek legal council before providing a DNA sample or allow his cell phone to be forensically extracted. [REDACTED] told me he would contact me on December 12, 2022 to finalize his decision.

4. On December 12, 2022, I processed the audio recording of the interview into evidence at the Moscow Police Department (MPD) and transferred the recording to MPD Evidence Technician Tim Smallridge.

5. On December 13, 2022, at about 5:00 p.m., I contacted [REDACTED] by phone after he failed to contact me the previous day. [REDACTED] told me he did not believe he had done anything wrong, he had been a "...good Samaritan..." by allowing Goncalves to be [REDACTED], and he didn't understand why he was on the contact list in the first place, therefore he was declining to provide a DNA sample or his phone for extraction.
