Narrative

1. On November 17, 2022, at approximately 1246 hours, I, Idaho State Police Detective Matthew Heinle along with Detective Brady Walker followed up with a tip phoned in by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] via Moscow Police tip Line. [REDACTED] claimed she may have helpful information regarding case D22000030.
2. Detective Walker and I called [REDACTED] and spoke with a female who identified herself as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/2001) and affirmed she had called the police tip line. [REDACTED] said she was a [REDACTED] and lived at [REDACTED] in Moscow, Idaho but her home of record was in Boise. [REDACTED] told Detectives she met Maddie (Madison Mogen) for the first time on Saturday night (November 12) while out with friends at the Corner Club (a popular bar in Moscow, Idaho).
3. [REDACTED] described that Saturday night as follows:
 - a. At approximately 2215 hours, [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to Mingles (a popular bar in Moscow, Idaho). [REDACTED] said she remained sober and acted as the designated driver.
 - b. At approximately 2315 hours, [REDACTED] left Mingles with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and drove to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] to drop them off.
 - c. [REDACTED] then drove to the Corner Club to meet up with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). Upon arrival, the Corner Club was packed, and [REDACTED] had to wait in line to get in.
 - d. [REDACTED] got into Corner Club, used the bathroom, and found [REDACTED] [REDACTED] found [REDACTED] and introduced [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]
 - e. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] separate from [REDACTED] and hang out for a while before [REDACTED] left the bar.
 - f. [REDACTED] met back up with [REDACTED] who was hanging out with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] was unsure if that was [REDACTED] last name), [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] roommate) and Mogen. This is where [REDACTED] met Mogen for the first time.
 - g. Mogen hung out for a while, then made a comment to the effect of, she was going back to hang with her other friends and left the group.
 - h. While in the Corner Club, [REDACTED] said there was an unknown male dressed in dark clothing and possibly a white and black stripped shirt that appeared to be very drunk. [REDACTED] stated the male was stumbling around and even fell into a group of people at one point. [REDACTED] said the male smelled as if he defecated in his pants. [REDACTED] mentioned he appeared to be there alone and never saw him talking with anyone.
 - i. [REDACTED] said she and another female she referred to as [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] could not remember her name) went to use the bathroom around 0030 hours and they ran back into Mogen. [REDACTED] said Mogen reminded her they were both named [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] made the comment to the effect of, "Yeah, I remember. I'm sober." To which Mogen replied to the effect of, "Well I'm not." [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] continued to the bathroom and did not see Mogen again after that.
 - j. At approximately 0145 hours, [REDACTED] arrived at her house after taking [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] home.

- k. [REDACTED] said as she parked and got out of her car, she saw a large male wearing a jacket walk out of a nearby house. [REDACTED] said she was by herself and felt uneasy about the male and just wanted to get inside quickly. [REDACTED] did not see where the male walked to, but saw he was headed toward Elm Street (Greek Row).
4. [REDACTED] told Detective Walker and I she did not become aware of the incident until approximately 1300 hours on Sunday (November 13) via the Vandal Alert text message and email alert system used by the University of Idaho.
5. [REDACTED] said she had nothing else to add at that time but was available for follow up if needed.
