Narrative					

1. On November 19, 2022, at approximately 1200 hours, I, Idaho State Police (ISP), Detective Timothy Snell, and ISP Detective Cody Herman followed up on tip 0641. I contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] to obtain surveillance video from October 16 through October 20 for an apparent incident that occurred in the area of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] which is adjacent to the [REDACTED]. At approximately 1433 hours, I received an email from [REDACTED] which contained a link to download the video she uploaded to a shared folder. At approximately 1723 hours, I forwarded the email and link to [REDACTED] to download the video content and retain for evidence.
2. At approximately 1500 hours, ISP Sergeant Jess Stennett, Detective Herman, and I were assigned to complete canvassing for cameras in the residential neighborhood located south of 1122 King Street residence. We were unsuccessful in locating any video appearing to be relevant to the homicide, the following areas were covered:
- a. Addresses between 342 through 1830 Victoria Drive. We reviewed video at [REDACTED], however there was no video content on November 12 or November 13, 2022. [REDACTED] had a camera facing the roadway; however, after later speaking with homeowner, [REDACTED] the camera battery had died and was not recording.
- b. Addresses between 1752 through 1933 Fletcher Place. [REDACTED] had what appeared to be multiple cameras; however, after speaking with the homeowner, we learned they were non-functioning cameras used to deter crime. Video was reviewed at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with no video content of relevance.
- c. Addresses between 1623 through 1956 Sunnyside Avenue. Video was reviewed at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with no video content of relevance.
- d. Addresses between 1875 through 1978 Anderson Place. Video was reviewed at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with no video content of relevance.
- e. At approximately 1800 hours, ISP Sergeant Jess Stennett and I left a voicemail for Trooper Keeley in reference to Tip 0105 who wanted to provide information regarding the homicide investigation located at 1122 King Street, Moscow, Idaho.
3. On November 20, 2022, at approximately 1143 hours, ISP Detective Andy Hodl and I contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by telephone to set up an interview. The phone call was recorded. [REDACTED] eventually answered and agreed to call back later to arrange a time for an interview.
4. At approximately 1216 hours, Detective Hodl and I contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED] by telephone to follow up on

information he wanted to provide investigators. The phone call was recorded. The tip was regarding a light colored four door sedan he had an interaction with on November 11, 2022. [REDACTED] described the driver of the sedan as being a white male wearing a long beanie that covered his hair. [REDACTED] said the unknown male confronted him in an unprofessional manner about throwing his trash into a dumpster that belonged to the neighboring apartment complex. [REDACTED] said the unknown male stated he was the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for the [REDACTED]. For full details of the phone interview, refer to the audio recording.

5. On November 25, 2022, Trooper Keeley returned my message and contacted me. Trooper Keeley who works for the Wyoming Highway Patrol provided me information on a subject named [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]/1982). Trooper Keeley emailed me a brief description of his encounter with [REDACTED] and his vehicle information.

6. On November 28, 2022, I requested ISP Regional Communications Center check [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (Washington Registration [REDACTED] through the license plate reader database. I forwarded the emailed information I received to ISP Detective Gideon Roberts.

7. All media and recordings were turned over to the Moscow police department labeled D22000030_0079.
