

On November 19, 2022, at approximately 1500 hours, I, Idaho State Police Detective Matthew Heinle along with Detective Andy Hodl conducted a canvass of the neighborhoods of Ridge Road and Paradise Drive in Moscow, Idaho. The purpose of the area canvass was to identify houses with doorbell or external cameras and collect footage during the early morning hours of Sunday, November 13, 2022.

Narrative
a. Residence had a doorbell camera, but it did not appear to be working. House was under construction and did not appear to be occupied. A neighbor told Detective Hodl and I the house had been crashed into by cars on two separate occasions recently.
b. Residence had external cameras, but the homeowners were not home/did not answer the door. A business card was left at the front door. No footage was collected.
c. Residence had an external camera but is live-feed only and does not record. Detective Hodl and I spoke with homeowner who was been was home on Sunday morning but did not hear or see anything noteworthy. No footage was collected.
d Residence had no cameras but spoke with homeowners. They were home on Sunday morning but did not hear or see anything noteworthy.
e Residence had a doorbell camera, but homeowner told Detective Hodl and I it was not functioning on Sunday. No footage was collected.
- Residence had a doorbell camera. Homeowner answered the door through the camera and stated they were in Spokane, Washington but would be home the following day (Sunday, November 20). Homeowner said they would be available to meet after 1400 hours. On November 20th at approximately 1400 hours, I went back and meet with the second of the incident. I reviewed doorbell camera footage and it did not record or store any events or footage prior to, during or after the timeframe of the incident.
g Residence had external cameras but homeowner , did not pay for a cloud storage service so his cameras only have enough memory to hold 2 - 3 days before being overwritten. Via a Wyze app on his iPhone, was able to review video sent to the cloud but could not download or email it. took a screen recording of the videos and Air Dropped it to my work phone. That footage was later downloaded by Moscow Police Detective Lawrence Mowery at the Moscow Police Department. Later that evening, at approximately 2141 hours, texted me another video date and time stamped 11/13/2022 at 0413 hours. Detective Heinle sent Detective Mowery the additional video.
h. Residence had a doorbell camera, but the lens was cracked and broken. The camera does work but video is distorted. Homeowner does not pay for storage service and there were no historic videos available. No footage was collected.
- Residents of this address saw the police canvassing through their doorbell camera but did not answer the door. When they realized it was the police, they drove around the neighborhood to find the police and speak with them. They had cameras but nothing of note was captured. No footage was collected.
