**Narrative**

1. Between the dates of November 26, 2022 and December 6, 2022, Detective Sgt. Tim Hopkins from the Idaho State Police District 6 Investigations Office and ISP Detective Derek Brown were assigned several tips to follow-up on and conducted several interviews related to the tips.
2. Tip #1841 requesting an interview of .
3. On November 27, 2022, Sgt. Tim Hopkins and Det. Derek Brown contacted and interviewed about his knowledge of events surrounding the homicide. told us the following:
4. On the evening of November 12, 2022 and the early morning hours of November 13, 2022 he was hanging out at the Corner Club bar with several people, including Kaylee Goncalves and Madison Mogen.
5. His girlfriend was also there. He spent the whole night with her.
6. Everyone was drinking alcohol that night. They were not using any recreational drugs.
7. His friend had been invited to Kaylee's house the night of November 12, 2022 but chose not to go.
8. He got into an argument with someone at the bar but does not know who it was. He drank out of the person's beer. He apologized and offered to buy the guy another beer.
9. He is not a cocaine dealer.
10. provided phone number as and phone number as .
11. Tip #2673 requesting an interview of regarding her interaction with fellow law student .
12. On November 28, 2022, Sgt. Hopkins and Detective Brown interviewed . During the interview told us the following:
13. She is in the program at U of I with . She had a conversation with after the homicide had occurred. During her conversation referenced the Moscow Homicide and compared it to the mass shooting at Virginia Tech from 2007.
14. told her the suspect in the VT shooting had killed two people prior to conducting the shooting on campus.
15. While talking about the VT shooting breathing was rapid, heavy and visible through his clothing and he had visible sweat on his upper lip.
16. did not mention anything specific about the homicide in Moscow, ID.
17. talked about a murder which took place in 2017 at the Fred Meyer in the Tri Cities area. said the suspect in that murder was at one time his roommate. He tried to get his roommate help and called the police about him prior to the shooting.
18. in the Tri Cities area.
19. She does not know where lives in the Moscow area and she does not know what he drives.
20. phone number is . He is back in town.
21. was birthday. On November 13th she was invited to a brunch for . She did not attend the brunch.
22. On November 30, 2022, Sgt. Hopkins and Det. Brown interviewed us the following:
23. We were talking to him because he was a Marine.
24. He does own K-bar knives. They are in his safe at his property in the Tri Cities.
25. was his birthday. He and some of his friend went to Rico's in Pullman, WA. He met a woman there named phone number . was later identified as .
26. He and took a Lyft ride to his apartment in Moscow and arrived at approximately 2:30 a.m. He was very drunk. was giving him water. stayed with him until the morning of the 13th.

27. His roommate [REDACTED] answered the door and let him and [REDACTED] into the apartment.
28. [REDACTED] showed me the Lyft route and receipt from the app on his phone. The receipt showed the Lyft left [REDACTED] in Pullman, WA at 2:10 a.m. and arrived at [REDACTED] in Moscow, ID at 2:28 a.m.
29. On November 30, 2022, Sgt. Hopkins and Det. Brown contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] roommate regarding [REDACTED] statements. [REDACTED] told us the following:
30. He received a phone call on Nov 12th to open the door for [REDACTED] and let him in. [REDACTED] was drunk and he was with a girl who would not show her face to him.
31. On December 1, 2022, Sgt. Hopkins and Det. Tyler Barrett conducted a follow up interview with [REDACTED] over the phone to clarify his time frame of activities. During the phone call [REDACTED] told us the following:
32. He was drinking heavy and fucked up all weekend. The days kind of run together. On the 13th he went to brunch and then hooked up with [REDACTED] later identified as [REDACTED] for dinner. [REDACTED] came back to his house and stayed the night. He took [REDACTED] to breakfast in the morning and then dropped her off.
33. He is out of town in the Tri City area for the next couple of weeks. He is willing to provide a DNA sample once he gets back into the area.
34. He will help in any way he can to catch the person who did this.
35. [REDACTED] phone number is [REDACTED]
36. On December 1, 2022, Sgt. Hopkins and Det. Brown contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED] WA DL [REDACTED] regarding [REDACTED] activities. [REDACTED] told us the following:
37. She met [REDACTED] the evening of the November 12th. They were at [REDACTED] and went bar hopping. [REDACTED] was very drunk and could not find his friends. She was giving [REDACTED] water.
38. They took a Lyft back to [REDACTED] house in Moscow, ID. The house stunk like dogs. She stayed there that night.
39. She did not go to brunch on November 13th.
40. She met with [REDACTED] for dinner on the 13th. They had dinner and then stayed the night together.
41. She has not seen [REDACTED] since the morning of November 14th when they separated.
42. On December 1, 2022, ISP Detective Brown and Sgt. Hopkins interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] regarding his knowledge of the homicide and his whereabouts on November 12th and 13th, 2022. The tip on [REDACTED] came from ISP Det. Lee Edgley who observed [REDACTED] during the memorial. This interview was not recorded. During the interview [REDACTED] told us the following:
43. He attended the memorial for the victims. He probably looked out of place because he was standing off to the side alone.
44. He did not attend the memorial with anybody.
45. He works in the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] building on campus and is a [REDACTED] student.
46. He did not know any of the victims. As a [REDACTED] student he does not socialize with any under classman.
47. He worked, went on walks, and was with his girlfriend at his apartment from November 11-13.
48. He drives a white [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
49. He did not want to provide a DNA sample.
50. On December 3, 2022, Detective Brown and Sgt. Hopkins interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] over the phone. This interview was not recorded. [REDACTED] refused to give us any personal information and would not say where she got her info. During the interview [REDACTED] told us the following:
51. She has a friend of a friend from out of state who has looked into this case.
52. She read about the case on websites and believes [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is involved. Her friend found [REDACTED] [REDACTED] from the [REDACTED] fraternity web site and looked at his eyes.
53. She does not know how her friend of a friend picked out this information.
54. On December 3, 2022, Detective Brown and Sgt. Hopkins interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] about his whereabouts on November 12th and 13th, his knowledge of the fraternity, and his knowledge of the homicide. During the interview [REDACTED] told us the following:
55. He was previously interviewed during Thanksgiving break, November 18th, by the FBI in Boise, Idaho.
56. He was asked about the victims and [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
57. Xana Kernodle was his Greek little. A Greek little is not someone you are pursuing, but a friend who becomes

part of your Greek family.

58. His big told him to hang out with a few different houses, like the [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED]. They would have events where only their littles were invited.

59. He was the [REDACTED] of his house. They are currently in a transition period after their election. He is helping the new guy get up to speed.

60. Last year he was the [REDACTED]. He knows everyone in the frat pretty well.

61. The house gets a little cliquey based on pledge classes.

62. He had classes with Mattie Mogan since his freshman year and he met Kaylee Goncalves through Mattie. Mattie had been dating [REDACTED] for a little while.

63. [REDACTED] was his [REDACTED] in the fraternity. [REDACTED] was the one who told him he was going to little Xana.

64. [REDACTED] his little [REDACTED] is taking over for him as the [REDACTED].

65. He knows [REDACTED] pretty well. [REDACTED] will be done in a semester.

66. He and Kaylee started talking about a month prior to the homicide. She would come back with him and stay at the fraternity.

67. They talked on Saturday at the [REDACTED] pregame party where Kaylee apologized to him and wanted to go to the game with him. He had already had plans to go to a sorority formal that evening with [REDACTED].

68. Kaylee texted him that night, he ignored it.

69. Kaylee was pretty drunk on Saturday. She was probably texting others to hang out as well. The texts were through snap chat. Snap chat deletes after 24 hours.

70. They mainly use snap chat. They will create large 40 person groups on snap chat to communicate.

71. His primary way to communicate is through snap chat. He never really had standard text message conversations.

72. [REDACTED] is still a [REDACTED] and lives by himself on [REDACTED].

73. He was out of the picture on Saturday because of being at the formal.

74. He usually knows where the guys are going to be and where they are comfortable going.

75. His frat is comfortable going to Xana's house for a party.

76. He is not aware of everybody's relationships with the victims. If there was someone who was not allowed to Xana's house, he would know.

77. Mattie and [REDACTED] were pretty enamored with each other.

78. He does not know who was hooking up with who within the group of people.

79. [REDACTED] is dating [REDACTED] from Boise.

80. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] from the frat house had gotten with [REDACTED].

81. He feels pretty terrible about what happened.

82. [REDACTED] was the last [REDACTED] of the fraternity. [REDACTED] was visiting the weekend of the homicide and was staying at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is a cabin at the end of [REDACTED].

83. On Nov. 13th between eleven and twelve o'clock [REDACTED] got a hold of him and told him something had happened at Xana's house and to do a head count.

84. A head count is a sprint through the house for people to count their pledge class and make sure they can get a hold of everyone. [REDACTED] was the only house member they could not get a hold of during the head count because he was with the people who found the bodies.

85. [REDACTED] is a member of his pledge class. [REDACTED] is a good friend of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] still lives in the frat house and just finished his role as [REDACTED] on the house board. [REDACTED] was present during the head count.

86. [REDACTED] is known as a night owl. They don't usually see him until about noon.

87. [REDACTED] has popped up on the university radar a couple of times because of [REDACTED].

88. [REDACTED] got into a fight at corner club one night. [REDACTED] just recently, approximately three or four weeks ago, got into a fight at [REDACTED] formal.

89. All of them were at the Corner Club and nobody saw the altercation.

90. The university is still looking into the fight at [REDACTED] formal event.

91. He was gone on the weekend of the formal.

92. It looks like [REDACTED] was in the wrong place at the wrong time and got caught in the middle of the altercation.

93. He recommended to the university that [REDACTED] write apology letters to the university and to the [REDACTED] sorority.

94. The [REDACTED] house is now waiting to hear if they are on suspension or not based on the formal

incident and a couple of hazing allegations.

95. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] where both involved in the incident at the [REDACTED] formal and are knocking on deaths door, they will probably get cut from the chapter.

96. [REDACTED] was the one who instigated the altercation.

97. The frat house has a general door code to access the house. The door code needs to change more frequently. They also have a couple doors on the first floor they [REDACTED].

98. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been in the house for four years and are on their way out of the house this spring.

99. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have also been told to not go out with them for a while.

100. His other little sister [REDACTED] hosted the party on Friday at the [REDACTED]

101. He gave verbal consent and signed a written consent form for law enforcement to download the contents of his cell phone. (The written consent form has been added as an E-file).

102. ([REDACTED] phone was turned over to FBI Special Agent Rob Hillie who coordinated the download of its contents. At the conclusion of the interview [REDACTED] phone was returned to him).

103. On the 13th they woke up, did the head count and tried to get a hold of their friends.

104. He checked on everyone. He called [REDACTED] and checked to see if he was okay.

105. He and [REDACTED] went to get food at McDonalds and checked on the guys at [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

106. While he was getting food with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was doing all right. They talked back and forth about getting a hold of Xana, speculating that maybe she was talking to the police.

107. They tried to stay positive.

108. At three or four they got an update from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that four people were dead. By Monday almost everyone had gone home.

109. He was talking to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that day and was into some snap chats with others about what was going on.

110. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are the two from the house he hangs out with the most.

111. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stayed over with him on Saturday night. [REDACTED] was in his room with him all night. [REDACTED] is a [REDACTED]

112. He was at the party at the [REDACTED] until about 4 p.m. Then he went to sober up so he could go to the formal with [REDACTED] The formal was held at the [REDACTED]. They got back to the [REDACTED] at about 11 p.m.

113. They were probably about 60 or 70 people in the apartment attending the party at the [REDACTED]

114. Once he left the party he detached from the events for the night.

115. [REDACTED] drives a blue [REDACTED] [REDACTED] drives a silver [REDACTED] [REDACTED] drives a [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] drives a small white car, maybe an [REDACTED]

116. On December 3, 2022, Det. Brown and I interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] over the phone. [REDACTED] told us the following:

117. She attended a formal on the 12th with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] After the formal she stayed the night at [REDACTED] frat house.
