Narrative

1. On November 18, 2022, I, Idaho State Police (ISP) Detective Richard Alderson was assigned Tip #0247. ISP Detective Matt Heinle and I conducted the investigation into this tip, and the information gathered from this investigation was relayed to the lead investigators.
2. According to Tip #0247, an [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (dob [REDACTED]/1991) had supposedly exhibited stalking behavior and an extreme fascination with females in the past at [REDACTED]. According to the tip, [REDACTED] changed his name to [REDACTED].
3. ISP Detective Heinle and I attempted to call the person providing the tip, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] but she did not answer the phone. We went to the [REDACTED] to see if anyone else had knowledge of [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]. The manager and a worker did recall [REDACTED] and they recall observing [REDACTED] stalking behavior firsthand. They did not have any further knowledge of [REDACTED] beyond these events at [REDACTED].
4. They also told us about a college aged male and female who had come into the store asking for a K-bar, and then left immediately after learning that [REDACTED] did not carry them. (Detective Heinle took over the task of acquiring the video of this incident.)
5. Detective Heinle and I went to [REDACTED] current employer, [REDACTED], to see if she was working. [REDACTED] was not there.
6. Detective Heinle and I went to [REDACTED], which was supposedly [REDACTED] last place of employment. [REDACTED] was no longer employed there, and when we talked to the owner of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] he claimed he did not know of a [REDACTED]. When we asked if he knew anyone named [REDACTED], [REDACTED] said yes. [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] had worked for him for approximately two months before terminating [REDACTED] employment because of his awkward social interactions with customers. [REDACTED] was not aware of any violent tendencies or stalking encounters from [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was simply an odd guy with awkward social skills.
7. [REDACTED] called my phone, and we spoke with her about the tip she had provided. [REDACTED] confirmed [REDACTED] awkward and stalking behavior directed at her. [REDACTED] also informed us that [REDACTED] had actually stalked another employee, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] until [REDACTED] had gotten a restraining order against [REDACTED].
8. [REDACTED] did not ever observe any violent behavior or acts from [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] had become more worried as [REDACTED] had begun to purchase more knives as time progressed. After [REDACTED] left employment at [REDACTED] she has not had any more interactions or issues with [REDACTED].
9. [REDACTED] was not aware of any relationships between [REDACTED] and any of the victims. Before ending the conversation, [REDACTED] advised us that she believed [REDACTED] was aware of a potential stalking incident with one of the victims. [REDACTED] was unable to provide details, and she was asked to have [REDACTED] contact us.
10. Detective Heinle and I drove by the location of [REDACTED] address provided by the tip, and it was not a residential area.
11. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] returned my voice mail, and we spoke via phone. [REDACTED] relayed to me similar observations as [REDACTED]. She added the fact that [REDACTED] had been driving a [REDACTED] with Washington license plate [REDACTED].

Narrative

12. [REDACTED] sister, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also returned my voicemail, and we spoke via phone. When asked about her knowledge of someone stalking one of the murder victims, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] relayed that she had simply heard rumors of this occurring. [REDACTED] claimed she did not possess any actual knowledge of any stalking.

13. After these interviews, we attempted to contact [REDACTED] via the cell phone number provided by the tip. The number was answered by someone claiming not to be [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The addresses provided by the tip and gathered during the investigation were also checked, and neither [REDACTED] nor his vehicle was located.

14. The progress of the investigation of this tip was relayed to the lead investigators, and our investigative efforts were directed elsewhere.

15. The case continues.
